the new evidence uncovers a number of behind the scenes plays such as nixon s secret nuclear alert of october 1969 and sheds more light on nixon s goals in vietnam and his and kissinger s strategies of vietnamization the china card and triangular diplomacy the excerpted documents also reveal significant new information about the purposes of the linebacker bombings nixon s manipulation of the pow issue and the conduct of the secret negotiations in paris as well as other key topics events and issues all of these are effectively framed by kimball whose introductions to each document provide historical context

this detailed two volume set considers the vietnam war one of america s longest and bloodiest wars from a topical perspective addressing the main characters and key events of the war and supplying many relevant primary source documents the vietnam war not only claimed the lives of nearly 60 000 americans and more than a million vietnamese but the prolonged conflict also resulted in a firestorm of protest at home that shook the foundations of the country and made u s citizens question the moral principles and motivations behind our foreign policy and military actions written in a very accessible style by recognized authorities on the war vietnam war a topical exploration and primary source collection provides students and general readers with a complete overview of the conflict in vietnam a broad topic that remains an important part of the american history and world history curriculum using a topical approach to cover all aspects of the war the set enables students to see the complete picture of the conflict through its presentation of reference entries and documents arranged in cohesive compelling chapters examples of the primary documents in the set include communist party evaluation of the tet offensive 1968 and president richard nixon s speech on vietnamization 1969 these primary sources are augmented by oral histories of soldiers who fought in the tet offensive additionally maps and images in each section enhance the aesthetic appeal of the book and heighten students understanding of the material readers will come away

the signing of the paris agreement in 1973 ended not only america s vietnam war but also richard nixon s best laid plans after years of secret negotiations threats of massive bombing and secret diplomacy designed to shatter strained communist alliances the president had to settle for a peace that fell far short of his original aim

in this study dr donald j mrozek probes various groups of americans as they come to grips with the consequences of the vietnam war he poses far more questions than he answers and some of what he says may invite strong dissent yet it will serve its author s purpose if something here provokes creative thinking and critical reexamination even of some long cherished ideas viewing the vietnam war as a logical outcome of american defense thinking has challenging implications as does seeing the cold war consensus on foreign affairs as an oddity the vietnam war stands uneasily on the edge of public memory slipping into the past and becoming part of our national history yet still too recent to be forgotten by those who lived through its trials but history seeks a meaning in its clouded events a retrospective order and pattern that could instruct and sometimes even inspire successive generations at present then americans face the peculiar dilemma of having to respond to the impact of a war for which there is still no comprehensively shared vision one cannot expect broad enthusiasm for a vision of the past whose primary purpose is to justify current policies acquisitions deployment and research americans have thought of themselves as individualistic and unruly people a flattering self image though in some ways a false one indeed during the vietnam war it was the patience and

long suffering of the american people that most deserved comment this was not the first war to fact great protest and challenge from americans opposition to a massive commitment that was killing young americans as well as many southeast asians should hardly have seemed surprising what should have caused real surprise was how long it took for opposition to coalesce in the end the vietnam experience ought to remind us of how well americans can rally to a cause even when it is poorly conceived and executed but these are not the lessons of vietnam they are only illustrations of how we may come to different understandings of the vietnam experience the central lesson is that even when we cannot control the circumstances around us we can still control ourselves the use of military and political resources to have our way is not only a practical and technical issue it is also a philosophical and moral one it may be worth asking if we have ever won a war by betraying our own traditions and values in this study dr donald j mrozek probes various groups of americans as they come to grips with the consequences of the vietnam war he poses far more questions than he answers and some of what he says may invite strong dissent yet it will serve its purpose if something here provokes creative thinking and critical reexamination even of some long cherished ideas viewing the vietnam war as a logical outcome of american defense thinking has challenging implications as does seeing the cold war consensus on foreign affairs as an oddity yet this is not a litany of objection and protest doctor mrozek raises serious questions about how the contemporary notion of deterrence has emerged and dealing with such questions forthrightly could make deterrence more effective so too questions the past relationship of military professionals with the mass media is not an assignment of guilt but an invitation to develop a beneficial and cooperative relationship nor is this study a tale of gloom and despair it is rather an appeal for self consciousness and self awareness it is a plea for us to take command of the problems that beset us by taking control of ourselves first

the vietnam conflict was one of the most controversial engagements in the history of the united states the effects of u s involvement the impact of an individual s participation political decisions and the politics of decision making are still felt the memorial itself was a topic of intense debate and yet it is one of the most visited sited in washington d c

in beyond the quagmire thirteen scholars from across disciplines provide a series of provocative important and timely essays on the politics combatants and memory of the vietnam war americans believed that they were supposed to win in vietnam as veteran and pulitzer prize winning author philip caputo observed in a rumor of war we carried along with our packs and rifles the implicit convictions that the viet cong would be quickly beaten and that we were doing something altogether noble and good by 1968 though vietnam looked less like world war ii s triumphant march and more like the brutal and costly stalemate in korea during that year the united states paid dearly as nearly 17 000 perished fighting in a foreign land against an enemy that continued to frustrate them indeed as caputo noted we kept the packs and rifles the convictions we lost it was a time of deep introspection as questions over the legality of american involvement political dishonesty civil rights counter cultural ideas and american overreach during the cold war congealed in one place vietnam just as americans fifty years ago struggled to understand the nation s connection to vietnam scholars today across disciplines are working to

come to terms with the long and bloody war its politics combatants and how we remember it the essays in beyond the quagmire pose new questions offer new answers and establish important lines of debate regarding social political military and memory studies the book is organized in three parts part 1 contains four chapters that explore the politics of war in the vietnam era in part 2 five contributors offer chapters on vietnam combatants with analyses of race gender environment and chinese intervention part 3 provides four innovative and timely essays on vietnam in history and memory in sum beyond the quagmire pushes the interpretive boundaries of america s involvement in vietnam on the battlefield and off and it will play a significant role in reshaping and reinvigorating vietnam war historiography

the lessons legacies and implications for future conflicts are the purpose of this collection of work on the american war in vietnam this is an assemblage of ten superb papers which outline why america failed in vietnam military readers will find the section on how the war was fought especially interesting in that the authors suggest that had we pursued a more exhaustive air campaign against the north early in the war then it could have been won this book is for serious students of the vietnam war for historians looking for a complete picture it has a superb bibliography and the authors have outstanding credentials armor the essays in this collection were assembled to provide answers to the question of why the united states lost the war in vietnam they examine four major factors that affected u s policy how the war was perceived how it was fought the possible effect of alternative strategies and the war s legacy for future warfare the contributors include both military officers and scholars all but one of whom participated in the vietnam war all the authors reflect the more tempered nature of current vietnam war scholarship although their appraisals differ the overall effect is to offer insight and clarification into the failure of u s and south vietnamese policy backed by the grinter s and dunn s first hand experiences
