author is a military historian and the book is narrated by his daughter in 2040 telling the story of the third world war as she observed and took part in it

written as though compiled shortly after the war's conclusion this imaginary history of the third world war describes why where and when it would be fought and what its effects would be

with nuclear stalemate holding the superpowers in check during the cold war violence proliferated in the third world sometimes this took the form of colonial liberation wars as the old european empires disintegrated after the second world war algeria 1954 1962 or kenya 1952 1959 sometimes the violence was between third world countries such as the iran iraq war and sometimes it involved the major powers directly the korean war the vietnam war the soviet intervention in afghanistan certain regions central america southern africa the horn of africa or the middle east have been in more or less perpetual turmoil for thirty years and more but whatever form the violence has taken protracted guerrilla activity against the central government or short sharp border war the big powers have always been involved they have provided arms to one or both sides they have supported their ideological protégés and more generally have manipulated such wars to their own advantage this book examines five broad categories of war colonial liberation wars big power intervention wars wars between third world countries the special area of israel and its neighbours and civil wars

as the war in europe entered its final months the world teetered on the edge of a third world war while soviet forces hammered their way into berlin churchill ordered british military planners to prepare the top secret operation unthinkable the plan for an allied attack on the soviet union on 1 july 1945 using us british and polish forces the invasion would reclaim eastern europe the controversial plan

called for the use of nazi troops and there was the spectre of the atomic bomb would yet another army make the fatal mistake of heading east in operation unthinkable jonathan walker presents a haunting study of the war that so nearly was he outlines the motivations behind churchill s plan the logistics of launching a vast assault against an enemy who had bested hitler potential sabotage by polish communists and he speculates whether the allies would have succeeded had the operation gone forward well supported by a wide range of primary sources from the churchill archives centre sikorski institute national archives and imperial war museum this is a fascinating insight into the upheaval as the second world war drew to a close and former alliances were shattered operation unthinkable became the blueprint for the cold war

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
